REACH registration and information requirements in the supply chain

On 1 June 2007, the EU Chemicals Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force. According to Article 33 (1), the supplier of articles containing a substance on the ECHA Candidate List (SVHC) in a concentration above 0.1% by mass has to provide the recipient of the article with information on the safe use of the article, at least the name of the SVHC concerned.

Würth Elektronik ICS GmbH & Co. KG (hereinafter referred to as ICS)

ICS as a manufacturer of electronic products and a so-called "downstream user" is aware of its obligations under the REACH Regulation.

ICS follows the changes of the so-called candidate list and strives to avoid the use of SVHC in its products.

Provisions are excluded from this confirmation.
